2010 Air Academy Scholarship

EAA Chapter 292 is now accepting applications for a scholarship to attend the EAA's **2010 Air Academy** in Oshkosh, WI. Complete information about the Air Academy can be found at: <http://www.young eagles.org/programs/airacademy/>

To be considered as a candidate for this scholarship the student must:

- Be 12 - 18 years of age and a resident of Oregon
- Be eager and available to attend an Air Academy session for the appropriate age group
- Submit an application form and a letter of interest
- Submit a letter of reference from a non-family member

Costs Covered by the Scholarship

- Full tuition for the Air Academy (\$600 to \$1000; includes all meals, lodging, and activities while at the Air Academy)
- Airfare to from Portland, OR to Appleton, WI (approx. \$700)
- Transportation from Appleton Airport to the Air Academy Lodge (provided by Air Academy)

Costs Covered by the Recipient

- Transportation from home to Portland International Airport
- Cost of food while traveling
- EAA National and Chapter 292 Membership (approx. \$30)
- Cost of a physical exam (documentation of a physical exam done within 24 months prior to the start date of the session will be required)
- Spending money while at the Air Academy

Application Checklist:

- Complete the application form and keep a copy for your files
- Write an application letter addressing the following questions:
 - Why do you want to attend the EAA Air Academy?
 - What aviation experiences, education, or training do you have to date?
 - What aviation experiences would you like to gain from your EAA Air Academy experience?
 - What aviation related career goals do you have that could be further advanced from your experiences at the EAA Air Academy?
- Obtain a letter of recommendation from a non-family member (teacher, scout leader, clergy, etc.)
